



GENERAL & EXTRA SUBJECT FEES FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR September 2017 – July 2018

School Fees

School Fees are set at an annual rate, split into three equal termly payments and are payable by direct debit on the first day of the term for which they are due. All fees are invoiced in advance with the exception of Incidental Expenses and Additional Specialist Support.

Day Fees (covering 8:00 am to 5:40 pm) £5,900 per term

Day fees are inclusive of a morning snack, lunch and afternoon tea and the catering team also provide nutritious food for a range of dietary requirements. The majority of after school clubs and activities are free of charge and girls may remain at school until 5:30pm to do supervised prep. Academic departments run free subject specific workshops and the majority of text books are provided.

Full Boarding Fees £9,975 per term

Weekly Boarding Fees £9,300 per term

Fees for Boarding include the same benefits provided for day pupils plus a cooked breakfast, supper and snacks from the boarding pantries. Laundry, evening activities, prep supervision and medical centre services are also provided. Boarding staff are able to arrange visits to the dentist and optician and will assist with travel arrangements.

School Transport

Prior's Field participates in the Eco Schools scheme and has been awarded two Green Flags, the highest level of award in the scheme. As part of this scheme, we strive to minimise the School's environmental impact and one of the ways the pupils can make a contribution is by using School transport. The school operates ten daily bus routes with connections to local towns and villages and to wider rail links via Godalming Station.

Day Buses: Parents are required to commit to a term's use of the service, five days per week. There is no refund for missed days. Concessions are available for tailored boarding and during the summer term for the public examination period.

Notice Periods

- One full term's notice, in writing to the Head, is required of a decision to withdraw a pupil. Change of status from Boarding (Tailored, Weekly or Full) to Day or within Boarding, requires the same length of notice.
- Any tuition, whether for Learning Support & EAL, Extra Tuition or Extracurricular Subjects (Riding, Speech & Drama, Tennis and Instrumental lessons), also requires one full term's notice in writing. The notice, in this case, should be sent to the Bursar.
- A decision to stop using School Transport (excluding the London Weekend Minibus) requires half a term's notice. 'One full term's notice' means notification that is received on or before the first day of the preceding term. Should the notice period not be adhered to, a term's fees in lieu of notice will be charged. 'Half a term's notice' means notification that is received on or before the first day of the preceding half term. Should the notice period not be adhered to, a half term's fees in lieu of notice will be charged.
